

Salvador Hector Ochoa, PH.D., President of Texas A&M University-San Antonio

In August 2023, Dr. Salvador Hector Ochoa became the third president of Texas A&M University-San Antonio. Dr. Ochoa earned his Ph.D. in School Psychology from Texas A&M University in 1989. As a tenured associate professor of education psychology

at Texas A&M University, Ochoa's research focused on bilingual psychoeducational assessment and education programming for Hispanic students. While a faculty member, he received the Texas A&M University Association of Former Students Distinguished Achievement Award in Teaching.

Prior to joining Texas A&M University-San Antonio as president, Ochoa served as provost and senior vice president for academic affairs at San Diego State University. Committed to fostering academic excellence and growth in diverse education settings, he also served as dean of the College of Education at the University of New Mexico and the University of Texas-Pan American, now UT-RGV.
